FACILITIES

Preparation/ Tuition spaces: The University has well equipped preparation spaces: courses and laboratories room equipped up to University standards.

Sports facilities: Indoor and outdoor sports facilities are provided for our students: football, handball, volleyball, basketball and tennis courts are available for ordinary sports activities, as well as two indoor fitness and fencing halls.

Sports performance activities such as: volleyball, fencing, tennis, fitness and bodybuilding are hosted by the University Sports Club of Târgu-Mureş.

The library: counts 210.000 volumes with 115.000 books and 96.000 magazines; other 200 volumes are available on the internet. The library has 27 branches within the clinics and certain discipline locations, as well. Also, 9 computer system with a high capacity server and 3 printers are available for the new ALICE library program that recently runs. Educational CD's, as well as periodical medical magazines are also available.

Web/ Internet facilities (www.umftgm.ro): - an international communication center is highly used by both teachers and students.

University Press- accredited by the National Council of Scientific Research from Higher Education- publishes didactical paperwork for students, as well as medical valuable research work, written by university teachers.

STUDENTS FACILITIES

Boarding facilities: 1175 boarding places are available in 4 boarding houses. Fee free students are boarded with priority. During admission exam, boarding places on charge are also available for accompanying persons.

Grants categories:

- **Excellence grant** – 300 RON / month;
- **Merit grant** – 250 RON / month
- **Studies grant** – 200 RON/month;
- **Social grant** – 150 RON /month.

Students League – of U.M.F. is an independent organization that promotes the rights and interests of its members, as well as an active participation to academic, social and cultural life. The League has Romanian and Hungarian students Associations with representative members within Teacher's Commissions and also 10 delegate members in the University Senate.

Our students could actively participate to all students mobility programmes, as U>M>F> is being included in research projects with foreign partners. The international academic exchange programmes, as well as bilateral conventions signed with the European Community are opportunities for students of all specializations. Licensed studies can be followed by master courses and PhD School of U.M.F.

JULY 2008 ADMISSION SESSION

Registration: 14-19 July 2008.

Admission fee: 150 RON (applicable for all specializations)

Admission procedures:

- I. For the sectorially regulated specializations in the European Union : *Medicine, Medicine in English language, Military medicine, Dental Science and Pharmacy* – admission with 3 hours multiple choice written paper is required.

- II. For the general regulated specializations in the European Union: *General medical care and Midwives* and the specializations *Dental Science, Dental Care, Pharmacy, Balneal - physiokinetotherapy and recovery, Nutrition and dietetics* a file contest will be organized, the entrance grade is calculated as the arithmetic average of high school finals and the average of the baccalaureate examination finals.

At the contest, high school graduates can take part and/ or students who want to follow a second specialization, obeying the conditions below. Citizens of the European Union countries can take part, of the member countries of the European Economic Space and of the Swiss Confederation, under the same legal descriptions as for Romanian citizens, including tuition fee terms and conditions.

The candidates can enrol into several admission exams, paying only one enrolment fee. Any risks concerning the rescheduling of some of the exams, as date or time, which may lead to the failure of the candidate to sit the examination, are the responsibility of the candidate.

In case a candidate is admitted to several specializations, the candidate has to opt for the one that will be subsidized by the State, by presenting the file with the required original documents before the deadline set by the University.

In order to enrol in the entrance examination, the candidates have to fill in an application form, in which they will declare all the requirements of form. Candidates belonging to national minorities will state in the form the subjects they studied in their mother tongue during high school and the one they wish to have the entrance exam

in their mother tongue. By signing the form, the candidate takes the responsibility for the filled-in details, including the fact that they have acknowledged the present Methodology of examination, as well as the obligation of permanently following the announcements related to the examination posted on the Notice board.

The following documents will be attached to the application form:

- Baccalaureate certificate or a certificate equivalent to it, original or authenticated copy, 2008 graduates can attach a proof of high school graduation and of the fact that they have passed the baccalaureate examination, mentioning the average of the baccalaureate examination and the finals of the high school studies
- Register extract, original or equivalent
- Certificate of birth, authenticated copy
- Medical certificate issued by the medical surgeries (school or territorial), proving that they are able to attend the specialization for which they opt, endorsed by the Student Surgery of Târgu - Mureş
- 3 identity card type photographs
- Proof stating that the candidate is enrolled into another university (for the candidates for a second specialization)
- In the case when the candidate opts for the entrance examinations of another university, instead of the baccalaureate certificate or its equivalent, the candidate will attach a copy of this and the copy of the identification card of the other university which will be authenticated by the secretarial office of the university, or a proof of registration where the candidate has their original documents
- Proof of paying the examination fee
- Documents proving the justification of request of sparing of payment of examination fees
- Two envelope-like folders

The following candidates can enrol without sitting the entrance examinations, on subsidised positions: high school graduates with a baccalaureate diploma who have received during high school years prizes (1st, 2nd, 3rd, honourable and special prizes) at International Subject-based Contests as well as candidates with 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes at National Subject-based Contests or in groups of countries at one of the entry examination subjects. The students who have won distinctions during high school at International Subject-based Contests can be admitted to two specializations places financed by the state.

Graduates with an academic degree of state universities can follow a secondary specialization, under the conditions issued by the Senate of the University.

The number of available places for this category will be set by the Senate of the University and will be made public.

Student enrolled in state universities can attend simultaneously two specializations, if they meet the requirements of the admission terms and conditions. During the first year, even if the students are enrolled at two different university centers, transferring is not allowed. In the national system of university education, during one cycle of studies, a candidate who has been admitted, can benefit by state financing for a single field and a single university.

All candidates, including married females, will be listed with their names in their birth certificates. In order to avoid confusion, during the identification process based on the identity card, it is imposed that, next to the name in the birth certificate, in brackets, the name in the certificate of marriage, adoption one or in the legal decision of the changing of the name be written, the initial being that of the father's, or, in special cases, that of the mother's.

Establishing the subjects for the entrance examinations:

The entrance examination will be based on multiple choice tests. Thus, the tests for all the subjects have been published and are available for the students. They constitute the bank of items for the examinations.

The textbooks used for this purpose are the alternative textbooks for high school students, approved by the Ministry of Education, Research and Youth.

The establishing of the tests for the written entrance examinations will be done by using a computer. Therefore, a computer software has been compiled, one that can generate numbers randomly, in order to ensure the security and objectivity of the establishing of the test questions. The questions will be generated in four variants using the computer software.

Setting and posting the results of the examination

The averages of the students are valid for establishing the rank only at the university, faculty and specialization for which the candidates have opted.

On request, the candidates below the "line of admission" can benefit from the places with tuition fee, within the limits of the approved places, in a descending order of the results.

The minimum admission result cannot be lower than 5 (five).

The candidates who are admitted are registered in the first year, for the ongoing academic year, by the decision of the rector.

If a candidate turns in the status of "student", acquired through examination, before the academic year starts, the vacant place will be occupied as follows:

- a) By one of the rejected candidates with the average (score) equal to the last admitted one, following the above mentioned terms and conditions;
- b) By one of the rejected candidates with an average (score) higher or equal to the minimum admission average (score), set by the methodology of the university, taking into account the list in a strictly descending order;
- c) By redistributing within the:
 - i) Faculty
 - ii) Universityunder the terms and conditions of the methodology of the university;
- d) It is published as available in the second session of admission examinations (for the vacant places from the first session).

Provisions c) and d) can be applied to the places that have not been occupied after the entrance examinations.

Other information referring only to Medicine in English language admission and studies:

Registration period: 14 – 31 July 2008 and 1st – 15 September 2008;

Admission fee: 150 RON;

The following documents will be enclosed:

1. Baccalaureate certificate
2. Register extract, original or equivalent
3. Certificate of birth, authenticated copy

Annual fee:

1. For citizens of European Union countries, Economical European Space countries and Swiss Confederation, the fee is **8500 RON**;
2. For citizens of other countries the fee is **4500 EUR** payable in four equal instalments.
The first instalment (**1125 EUR**) will be paid at registration, after admission.

Exchange rate (June 2008 estimation) : 1 RON = 3,62 EUR / 1 RON= 2,34 \$
